Several years ago, the Town of Cary established a Traffic Engineering Department. They work under Public Works and Cary's Engineering Department. They maintain 153 locations, 143 of which belong to NCDOT (everything inside the city limits and a couple of signals in Morrisville). NCDOT and the Town have a maintenance agreement where we pay the Town to maintain our signals. There is a Traffic Control/Management Center located at City Hall. They would be more than happy to show you.

They have 2 engineer technicians that monitor their traffic signal system via computer and cameras. The have a full time traffic engineer whose main responsibility is traffic signal timing throughout Cary and two other engineers that keep up with developers, city projects, etc. You can call David Spencer with the Traffic Engineering Department to get more information (462-3833)
